

CPCS or NPORS Plant Courses

Experienced Delegate test only (expect Dumper/Roller)

Short Duration Courses

Quality assured short courses to provide learners with certification to ensure they are working safely onsite. Courses can be developed and adapted to refer to or include specific areas of the client's operations, particularly focussing on issues that are present and utilising the client's own asbestos policies and procedures.

PDCOS (Petrol Driven Cut Off Saws)-

Certificate valid for 3 years

The course covers the use of equipment including the fitting of the cutting wheel. This course is gaining demand on site, due to the increased use of this type of equipment without the proper training.

Abrasive Wheel-

Certificate valid for 3 years

The Abrasive Wheels training course is intended for persons involved in the use, inspection or mounting of abrasive wheels and is designed to provide training as required under PUWER 98.

Asbestos Awareness-

Certificate valid for a year

The course is designed for personnel that undertake maintenance, refurbishment or building work.

Raising awareness of the dangers and the practical steps to be taken to reduce the risk of exposure.

Safe use of Ladders-

Certificate valid for 3 years

Ladders are a commonly misused piece of equipment, this course teaches understanding general hazards, restrictions, pre-use user checks of ladders and step ladders.

Vehicle Marshal-

Certificate valid for 3 years

Providing thorough understanding of the hazards associated with moving vehicles on a site and how to provide and maintain safe access routes for both pedestrians and vehicles.

Cable Locating Operator-

Certificate valid for 3 years –

People who are required to use CAT & Genny system in the workplace to locate buried services and ducting.

Working at Height-

Certificate valid for 3 years

This course raises awareness of the dangers associated with work at height and the practical steps taken to minimise and control the risks.

Fire Marshaller-

Certificate valid for 3 years

Delivered in compliance with the Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005. Ensuring that delegates are fully qualified to become a designated fire warden in their workplace. Providing a more in-depth understanding of the different types of fire, how they are caused, and how to prevent them.

Manual Handling-

Certificate valid for 3 years

Manual Handling course ensures that delegates hold an understanding of safe techniques to use when lifting and moving objects of varying size and weight, to avoid any injury to themselves or others.

Quick Hitch Awareness-

Certificate valid for 3 years

The course aims to provide delegates with work based learning in relation to quick hitch equipment, for Manual, Semi-Automatic and Fully-Automatic Quick Hitches, providing the information needed to check and maintain various types of quick hitch and the safe connection of various attachments.

Face Fit Testing

Under current legislation operators need to be face fit tested to ensure the wearer is fully protected from airborne contaminants. Understanding how to wear RPE correct, including being clean shaven.
